Rules: This race will be governed by *The Racing Rules of Sailing*, the prescriptions of US Sailing, and the rules of the respective class associations, except as altered by the Sailing Instructions.

Location and Skippers Meeting: *Meet on the water near the Sea Buoy at 12:30, listen to Channel 68 for RC information. You must check in and be acknowledged by RC.*

Start Time: 1:00pm for the first gun.

Course: We will announce the course on VHF 68 by letter followed by leave to Port or leave to Starboard. The ocean course marks that may be used are listed below. A mark may be used more than once in a race. Enter the marks in your GPS if you do not already have them there.

Ocean Marks

A Masonboro Inlet Sea Buoy RW Mo A
Buoy Location Position Approximate 34 10.382 N 77 47.917 W
This will usually be the start finish location but may also be used as a turning mark.

B Fish Haven Buoy AR 364 Yellow Can
Buoy Location in GPS ddm: 34° 14.833' N / 077° 42.833' W
General Location: 050° M, 6.2 nm from Masonboro Inlet sea buoy

C Fish Haven Buoy AR 370 Yellow Can
Buoy Location in GPS ddm: 34° 10.467' N / 077° 45.067' W
General Location: 100° M, 2.5 nm from Masonboro Inlet sea buoy

D CORMP Weather Buoy ILM 2 Yellow Structure
Buoy Location 34 08.330 N 77 42.958 W
General Location 124 M, 4.6 nm from Masonboro Inlet sea buoy

E Fish Haven Buoy AR 372 Yellow Can
Buoy Location in GPS ddm: 34° 06.217' N / 077° 44.950' W
General Location: 154° M, 5.0 nm from Masonboro Inlet sea buoy

F Carolina Beach Inlet Sea Buoy RW Mo A
Buoy Location Position Approximate 34 04.383 N 77 51.348 W
General Location 215 M 6.6 nm from Masonboro Inlet Sea Buoy

W, S, L, T WBORA temporary marks (Windward, Starting, Leeward or wing mark for a triangle course).

Classes: Expected classes include: PHRF Racing & Cruising.
